Traffic Control Technician (TCT) 8 hours



An introduction to temporary traffic control in work zones for individuals who work in

the field installing and removing traffic control devices. The course provides concepts, techniques and practice exercises in the installation and maintenance of traffic control devices. This course provides a wealth of information for those trying to enter the field as a certified traffic control technician.

Course includes basic training on:

- · Deployment and maintenance of typical work zones
- Safety standards
- Traffic control devices
- Roles and responsibilities of a TCT
- Reading and executing Traffic Control Plans (TCPs)
- Work zone laws and MUTCD standards

Basic First Aid

5 hours

Basic First Aid is designed for People who want a general knowledge of first aid principles and the emergency treatment of injuries.



Course includes basic training on:

- · General first aid techniques and preparation
- CPR Level C: All aspects of CPR skills and theory for resuscitating adults, children, and infants.
- Automated External Defibrillator (AED) training

Traffic Control Supervisor (TCS) 16 hours

2 DAY COURSE

Designed to train those who will be actively involved in designing or setting up and maintaining temporary traffic control in a

work zone as a traffic control supervisor. It moves from the concepts and techniques taught in the TCT course to the implementation of traffic control plans and techniques for installation and removal.

Successful completion of the TCT course is a prerequisite for enrollment

Course dives deeper into TCT topics, and includes:

- Execution of more advanced traffic plans
- Supervisory Skills
- · Work area personnel roles and responsibilities
- ATSSA certification is available for attendees with the required 4,000 hours of jobsite experience, 2 years of employment and 2 references.

All courses are led by safety professionals with active and relevant credentials. Students will experience a hands-on learning environment with open discussion about current practices within the industry. Trainers are available for follow-up questions or advice beyond the selected course.
